

“EO, E LILI’U” SONG CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. Entrants must be students of the immersion or bilingual Hawaiian programs
2. All songs performed must be
 - a. from the Queen’s songbook or a song written for or about Queen Lili`uokalani **OR**
 - b. a song written for or about Kaua`i and Ni`ihau
3. Each group must perform 2 songs. A maximum of 10 minutes will be given to each group.
4. Instrumentals must be live (i.e., no recorded music). There will be no amplification for vocals and instruments.
5. Grades K-5: teachers may provide backup music for students.
6. Grades 6-12: backup music must be provided by students. There must be a minimum of 4 members per group. A group may include students from any grade within their grade category.
7. Judging criteria:
 - a. Harmony (for grades 6-12 only)
 - b. Accompaniment
 - c. Introduction/Mo`olelo
 - d. Presentation (i.e., lei, lole)
 - e. Phrasing
 - f. Melody
 - g. `Olelo Hawai`i
8. Prizes will be awarded in 2 grade categories K-5 and 6-12:
 - a. 1st prize = \$200
 - b. 2nd prize = \$150
 - c. 3rd prize = \$100
